Mr. Wong received his J.D. from Yale Law School in 2017, where he was a projects editor of the *Yale Law Journal* and a notes editor of the *Yale Law & Policy Review*. He served as a co-chair of the Asian Pacific American Law Students Association and was a member of the Media Freedom and Information Access clinic. Mr. Wong also organized the Copyright Law Workshop, bringing academics and practitioners to discuss issues in copyright law. He received the Nathan Burkan Memorial Competition Prize for the best paper in the field of copyright law and the Neale M. Albert Fund Prize for the best paper on art law.

After receiving his B.A. *magna cum laude* from Columbia University, Mr. Wong worked for two years as a middle school teacher in Massachusetts as part of the Teach for America corps and for one year as an English lecturer at a Chinese university.
