She also served as a student attorney in the Housing Law Clinic, representing victims of domestic violence in Massachusetts Housing Court and in an ultimately victorious case at the Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court, in which the court adopted the broadest housing protections for survivors of domestic violence in the country. Ms. Mannheimer was recognized by the Harvard Office of Clinical and Pro Bono Programs for completing 1,000 hours of pro bono service.

Ms. Mannheimer graduated from Northwestern University, *cum laude*, with a degree in Gender Studies and Political Science, and with departmental honors in Gender Studies for her thesis "From Wishes to Princes: Disney's response to popular notions of feminism in the production of princess films." She studied abroad at the Universidad de Sevilla in Spain.
